Since moving to England 6 years ago, I have grown accustomed to seasonal celebrations that are quintessentially British, such as the two that are approaching towards the beginning of this month: Bonfire Night and Remembrance Sunday.

Many people in this country see the leaves changing colour and the air growing colder and they might think immediately of fireworks or poppies. But no matter how long I live here, November will always make me think first and foremost of Thanksgiving.

In many ways, modern Thanksgiving has now come to be associated with things that the Pilgrims at Plymouth Rock would not have ever conceived of. Turkey, potatoes, and pecan pie were nowhere to be found in the early colonies, let alone American football games, parades, or Black Friday sales. But I'd like to think that in most families, the tradition of giving thanks still remains a central part of the Thanksgiving season.

Thanksgiving always reminds me each time it comes around that gratitude is such a simple and effective tool for us all. Cultivating a daily or weekly gratitude practice has been shown to have palpable positive effects on our mental and even physical wellbeing. Our liturgists must have understood this when they codified our birkot ha'shachar: the blessings we recite each morning which thank God for some of the basic things that enable us to live our lives. Next time you're in shul and come across these blessings, don't just read them by rote. Instead, really try to think about what we are giving thanks for in each blessing, and maybe even add a few of your own gratitude blessings to the list as well.

On behalf of the clergy team, I'm wishing us all sweetness, happiness and health as we enter into autumn, and I hope that these colder months are warmed by many moments of gratitude.

## **Services**

#### **Erev Shabbat Service**

Our Erev Shabbat Service takes place every Friday Evening. Led by our Rabbis in person at our Synagogue and through the EHRS Livestream Classic Channel. They give a beautiful sense of rest and togetherness to help you to cope with the stresses of the world.

### **Shabbat Morning Service**

Our Shabbat Morning Service is held in the EHRS Beit Tefillah (sanctuary). The service is also available on the EHRS Livestream Classic Channel.

### Saturday 16th November Remembrance and Eco Shabbat Service

Our classical service on this Shabbat will include our act of remembrance for those who lost their lives in the wars that Britain has had to fight over the past century, together with recognising the role in our national life of those who currently serve our nation. The Kiddush on this morning will highlight the environmental challenge of our future and our responsibility to preserve the earth. On **Sunday morning 10th November at 10:30am** we will gather at the Edgware War Memorial for our annual interfaith act of remembrance culminating at 11:00am with the two minute silence.

### Shabbat for the Eco Soul - 16 November

Join Rabbi Tanya on the National Eco Shabbat for a service celebrating nature and our responsibility for the environment. In person and includes time in our lovely new outdoor courtyards.

### **Children's Shabbat Experiences**

We aim for there to be a special Shabbat experience for children pretty much every week at EHRS. Our Shabbat Shirah and Shabbat Club on respectively the second and fourth Shabbat each month are especially created for children to enjoy. On the first and third Shabbat, from 10:45-11:15 our clergy and educators run a Story, Snack and Song time or Build a Bible sessions for any children that would like to join them. See Our Week Ahead for what is on this week. All are suitable for collecting CRP points for Jewish schools.

### **Kuddle Up Shabbat**

Our special interactive Shabbat service for Primary aged children and their siblings. Songs, stories and activities. You can collect CRP points from attending. Early arrival is optional from 15.45. Come straight from school pick up, or just arrive early to play before the service. Selection of toys for the children and hot drinks available for the adults.

### **Early Risers Service**

This especially friendly service is mostly in Hebrew, uses nusach (traditional modes of chant for the prayers), include the Torah reading and Musaf (which is the repetition of the Amidah special to Shabbat) and other features to create a participative experience, ending with a hospitable Kiddush

### **Sunday Shacharit**

Half an hour of morning prayer with a friendly bunch of folks, includes the Kaddish if you are remembering a loved one. On the first Sunday of each month, it includes a bagel breakfast.

### **Deep Torah Dive - next session 23 November**

Rabbi Mark enjoys translating Torah and trying to bring out the poetry of the Hebrew. In this parallel Torah reading experience we will work together on the meaning of this week's Parasha, Chayyei Sarah direct from the Hebrew to English. In person and on Zoom.






